FORD DIETH: "TEACHING IS A MINISTRY"



As in every profession, a person has to define their why. Why do you get up everyday and go to work? Why did you choose a particular career path? Why do you make personal and family sacrifices to make sure others are taken care of? For Canal Street Campus Co-Head of School, Mr. Ford Dieth, the answer is clear. Following the example of St. John Baptist De La Salle, founder of the Christian

Brothers who was pulled by God to teach children, Dieth shares his higher calling. "Teaching is a ministry," said Dieth.

Dieth began his Christian Brothers career through a relationship with CBS President Joey Scaffidi. "In 2002, I was teaching at Holy Rosary Academy where Mr. Scaffidi was a board member. One day he called me about an opening for a 5th Grade Teacher position at CBS. My respect for him and his vision and passion for Christian Brothers sold me right away," said Dieth. From 2002 until 2013, Dieth showed his versatility as a self-contained 5th grade teacher, as a self-contained 6th grade teacher, as a 6th grade mathematics teacher, as a Literature teacher, as a English II teacher, and as a

school counselor. Dieth shared more about his vocation at CBS stating, "The school content we teach at Christian Brothers is not unique; however, what is unique is how we deliver the content to our students."

After accepting a position at his alma mater, St Martin's, in 2013, Dieth continued to hone his craft in leadership and administration. At the same time, Christian Brothers was undergoing a change which would transform its educational model. "God provided an instrument confirming a new model for CBS to run. This was a huge milestone for the Canal Street campus," said Dieth. In 2022, Dieth was serving as interim Head Master at St Martin's when Scaffidi called with an offer for him to return

home. "Coming back here felt good and I have received incredible support from the teachers and the CBS families," said Dieth.

Dieth shares his conviction for the mission of CBS and his calling to fulfill his life's purpose. "I love when kids let me know I have had an impact on their life and that makes me clear on what we do here. I like being the guy they call for advice and help," said Dieth.

Joey Scaffidi confirms Dieth's higher calling of teaching is a ministry. "Ford Dieth has a heart for service and mission work. He is an advocate for kids, and he supports his teachers. He loves relationships and proudly represents all Christian Brothers School stands for. This is his ministry."

The Athletic Department at Christian Brothers School strives to provide the best middle school sports program in the New Orleans metro area. We are able to provide quality instructors and mentors because several of our faculty members who volunteer their time are former high school and college athletes. In addition, many parents who entrust their boys to CBS and who have competed at the high school, college and professional levels volunteer as coaches.

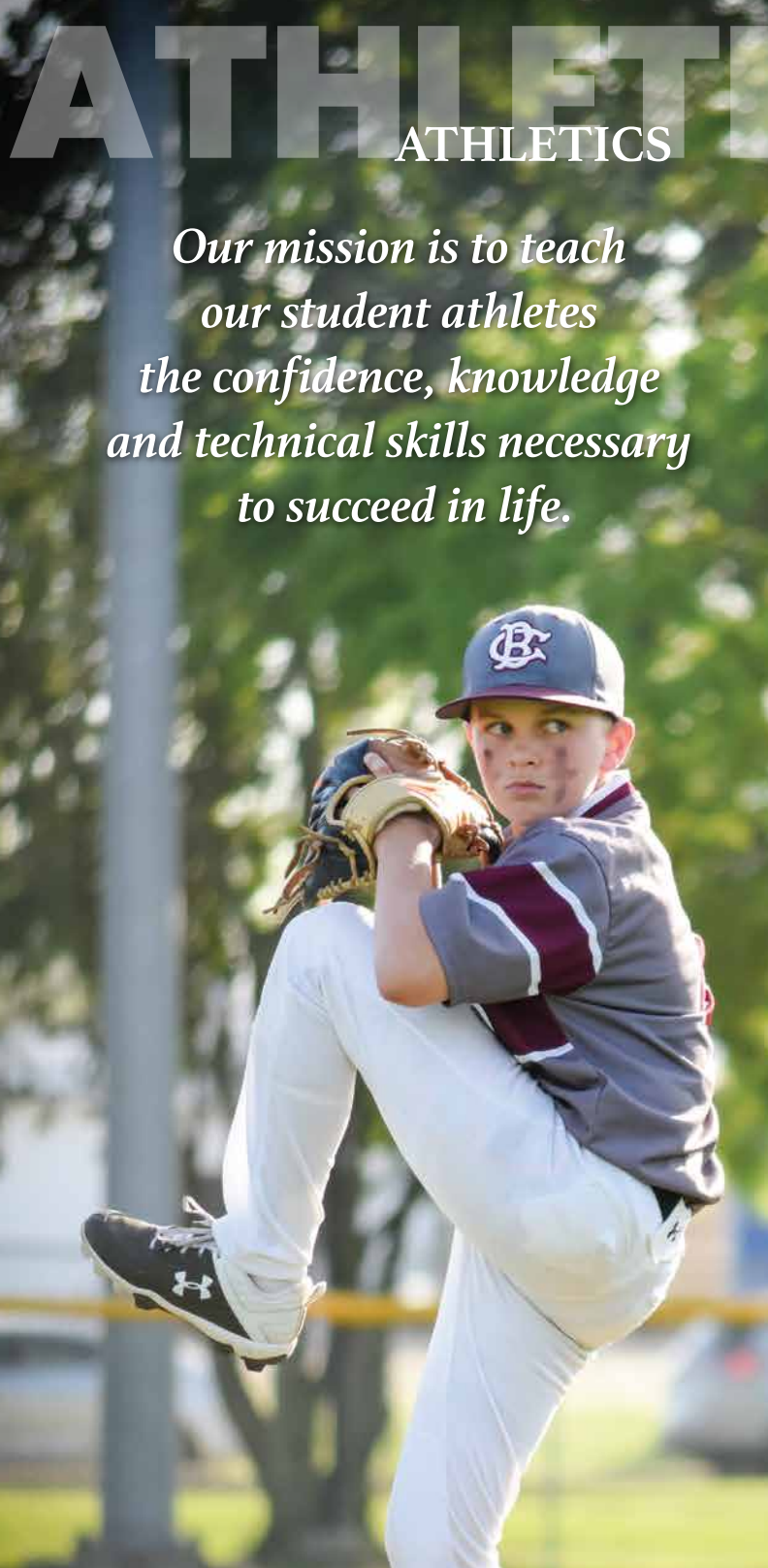

Since 1960, the Christian Brothers and their partners have fulfilled their commitment to providing a Christian education based on the timeless Traditions of St. John Baptist de La Salle and the Catholic Church.

A visitor from one of those early classes may notice some impressive changes: blackboards replaced with whiteboards and flat screens, all students using iPads, a cafeteria where they once practiced swimming and a second campus. That same visitor would also be impressed with what has not changed: the commitment to living the charism of the Brothers through our dedication to the five Lasallian core principles of:

Faith in the Presence of God

Concern for the Poor and Social Justice

Respect for All Persons

Quality Education

Inclusive Community

Faith in the Presence of God lives through our commitment to the sacraments and prayer. Mass is an essential part of the spiritual life of the school. We celebrate school-wide masses; each middle school homeroom has a special class mass with their families, and special school events, such as Pin Mass, First Communion, and Graduation, always occur in the context of a Mass. The students also receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation throughout the year.

Prayer begins each class; the entire school community unites in prayer. This repetition reinforces the teaching of our founder that we are always in the presence of God.

Concern for the Poor and Social Justice lives through our mission-drive collection, Falcon spirit drives, service day, and commitment to diversity, equity, inclusion, and belonging for all students and staff. The school wide, year-long mission collection supports the educational efforts of the Brothers in other parts of the world. Falcon spirit drives provide essential items for various local organizations, and our service day engages students in a variety of hands-on experiences for the community.

Respect for All Persons lives through our recognition that all people are children of God, made in His image, and who brings God to others. This recognition is stated in our prayer conclusion, where we ask God to help us keep Jesus alive in our hearts, and Jesus will help us to always be true disciples.

Quality Education lives through our classroom instruction. In all classes, qualified teachers, utilizing various strategies and methods, guide the student-learning experience. In daily religion classes, our students are formed in a deep knowledge and appreciation of the faith by qualified teachers using approved textbooks. The classroom experiences sustain the entire formation program.

Inclusive Community lives through our cultivation of a spirit of belonging via a friendly and welcoming school family that seeks to develop students' talents and abilities in a variety of offerings, including athletics, both intramurals and travel teams; the arts, including visual, music, and drama; and extracurricular activities, including biking, canoeing, and the learning landscape.





The Christian Brothers School Alumni Association is dedicated to fostering a spirit of camaraderie and service amongst CBS alums in coordination with the greater CBS community. The alumni association, of which all graduates of CBS are members, is led by a board of directors. The board organizes a variety of activities over the course of the year. The alumni association kicks off the school year with a Thursday Night Football Social on the big screen in the Cultural Center. Alums enjoy the game while socializing and being treated to good food, drinks, a bourbon bar, and cigars! This event is free of charge for all alums!



In the spring the association holds the annual Cocktail Party and Award Ceremony in which they recognize two people for their contributions to CBS and to the community at large. The St. Benilde Award is presented to a member of the CBS community who has contributed to the Brothers specifically and to Christian Brothers School. The recipient of the 2023 St. Benilde Award was Joey Scaffidi, A.F.S.C, for his ongoing work as leader of Christian Brothers School in the form of principal and president since 1998 and as an outstanding example of Christian Leadership in the field of education. The Alumnus of the Year Award is presented to an alum who has contributed positively to the greater community. The recipient of last year's Alumnus of the Year Award was Granville Morse, M.D. for his work with the school during Covid and over the years as medical consultant to the school and the athletic department in particular.



The association also holds an annual spring Crawfish Boil to which all alums and their families are invited. The highlight of the event is the cooking contest sponsored by various CBS alumni and their "team members." We also recognize the award winners at this ceremony as we enjoy crawfish, refreshments, and activities for the kids.

In addition to these three main events, the alumni board supports the school by sponsoring the Bloody Mary and Mimosa Booth at the school's annual fall picnic in October and the Bloody Mary Bar at the golf tournament in the spring. Each year the board sends birthday wishes to each of the dozens of Brothers in the San Francisco New Orleans District. Recently the board sponsored a "grassroots" effort to raise funds for Br. Laurence's and Br. Gale's summer trip to Europe!

In 1966 a group of men vitally interested in Catholic education in schools conducted by the Christian Brothers met to determine how they could dedicate funds to the goal of maintaining quality education in the schools of the Christian Brothers. Today the

Christian Brothers Foundation's mission is much greater. While still providing for continuing education for Brothers and lay teachers, the Foundation assists the Christian Brothers with much needed retirement resources, ongoing support to the Brothers of our CBS Community, and providing an annual donation to CBS in unbudgeted funds to be used at the President's discretion. In 2021 the Foundation was restructured to include the ladies' and men's parent clubs as part of the Foundation. This also brought representation of women onto the Board of Directors for the first time.

THE BROTHER EDWARD SCANLAN ENDOWMENT FUND

The Brother Edward Scanlan Endowment Fund (a multi-million dollar investment) was established in August of 2022. It is dedicated to offsetting anticipated future increases to tuition and to making a CBS education more viable to families of the greater New Orleans area for years to come. The goal of the endowment is to fund (partially at first and in full eventually) approximately \$400,000 in annual financial assistance to families in need. That amount is currently a line item expense in the budget funded by general tuition. Removing that line item expense reduces the cost of tuition to ALL while continuing to support those families in need. A portion of every event package is deposited directly to the Endowment. You could avoid paying income tax on your required minimum distribution (RMD) from your IRA? How? Make a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) from your IRA to Christian Brothers School and avoid taxation on the withdrawal from the IRA to satisfy your RMD requirements.
