
**Casino Night Rescheduled!!**

Registration is now OPEN for the tenth annual Archdiocesan Junior High Retreat! This year's retreat will take place March 21 & 22, 2026, at Camp Abbey Retreat Center in Covington. The retreat is open to all students in grades 5 through 7. We are thrilled to be able to offer this opportunity to the young people in the Archdiocese!

This year's retreat theme is, "Illuminate", and will center around the Scripture Matthew 5:13-16. The retreat will include a variety of activities, talks, prayer experiences, music, games, the Sacraments of Reconciliation & Eucharist, and more. It will also be a unique opportunity for your students to spend time growing in faith alongside other young people from across the Archdiocese!

The following is general information about this year's retreat, as well as the registration process:

1) **ELIGIBILITY:** The retreat is open to all students in 5th, 6th, & 7th Grades. While 8th grade is considered high school in Archdiocesan schools, depending on your ministry's individual dynamic, you may choose to send students in 8th grade.

Please contact the Youth Ministry Office to discuss 8th grade attendees.

2) **REGISTRATION:** Young people should register individually. They do not need to register as part of a group, or have chaperones from their parish in order to register. The Youth Ministry Office provides all retreat staff, which includes adult youth ministers and chaperones, as well as high school peer ministers from our Archdiocesan Teen CROSS ministry.
