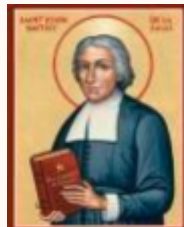

TerraNova Standardized Testing (Grades 3-7)

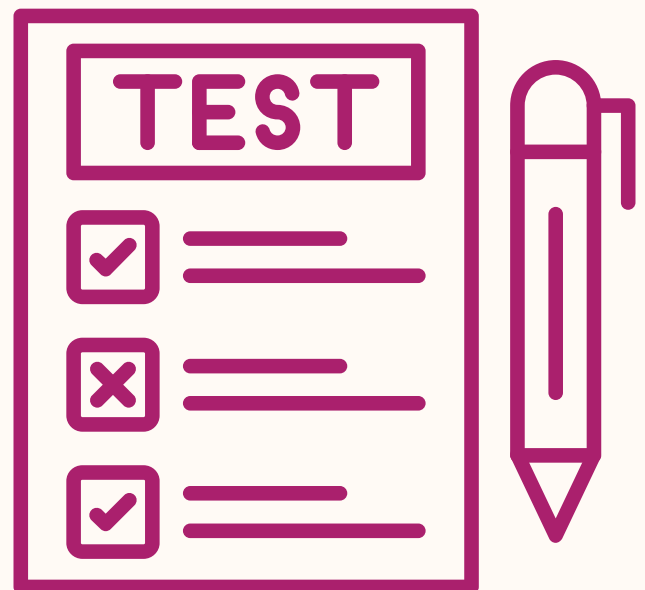
Standardized testing will take place from Tuesday, April 28, to Thursday, April 30.
